Disciplines: 100 m, 400 m, 1500 m, 5000 m, 3000 m walk, 4x100 m relay, 4x400 m relay (minimum age: 200 years for men, 180 years for women), long jump, high jump, pole vault, triple jump, shot put, discus throw, javelin throw, hammer throw.

Competitors: Each country may nominate two athletes per discipline for the evaluation of the official competition and in running disciplines also 4 unscored athletes per discipline 100m, 400m and 2 unscored athletes per other discipline. Each athlete may compete in a maximum of two individual disciplines and two relay disciplines. If an athlete has reached their participation limit in an official team competition, they cannot be registered as a non-scoring athlete in other disciplines.

Entry fee: €15 per athlete.

Registration: Athletes will be registered by team manager no later than 23.7.2026 at <https://statistika.atletika.sk/kalendar> on line. The team leader will receive a registration account from the organizer no later than 1.7.2026. Non-scoring athletes must be marked separately. The team manager will be able to update the registered athletes in the registration form until 6.8.2026 at 8 p.m.

Presentation (Team managers meeting): 7th of August at 7 PM in Hotel EMPIRE, street Jána Hajdóczyho 7736/11, 917 01 Trnava ([Contactus - Hotel Empire](#)) The team manager will take over the start numbers and vouchers for the Saturday gala dinner. The team manager can make the final adjustments to the nominated competitors until the end of the team managers meeting by reporting the changes to the organizer. The start of an athlete who has not been nominated is not allowed.

Changes in athlete nominations during competition: The team manager may request a change of the athletes nominated by him for the discipline at any time during the competition at the competition office, but the change must be made before the system closes, which is 60 minutes before the start of the discipline.

Opening ceremony: at 9:45 - each team should be represented by 10 athletes. After welcoming the athletes, the Slovak national anthem will be played.

Awards: Each team will be awarded a cup. In addition, the best male and female athlete of each team will receive individual awards based on the evaluation of the team managers.

SPORTS AND TECHNICAL CONDITIONS

The competition is organized according to the rules of WA, WMA and these technical rules.

Uniform: all athletes MUST wear a national competition top. A club singlet or vest is not acceptable.

Warmup area: outside the stadium, on the grass and asphalt area behind the main stands. Entrance to the stadium will also be allowed on Friday, August 7th between 6:00 PM and 8:00 PM.

Evaluation: All results will be recalculated using the WMA age graded factors (aging factory coefficient). The competitor's age will be determined as of August 8th, 2026. The final ranking will be determined based on the adjusted results. Points for individual disciplines: 12-11-10-9-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1 for positions from 1st to 12th place. Points for relay events: 12-10-8-6-4-2 for 1st to 6th place. In case of equal performance, split points will be awarded. Points will be calculated separately for men's and women's teams. The women's pole vault will only be evaluated if the nominated athletes are from at least 4 teams. The total results of the national team will be the sum of the points of the men's national team and the women's national team.

Starting Blocks and Starter's Commands: Starting blocks are not mandatory. Starter's Commands In accordance with WA rules, the starter will give the commands in English.

Competition Numbers (Bibs): The athlete must wear one bib, properly attached on the front of their competition top. The exception is for jumps and throws, where the bib may be placed on the front or back. In relay events, athletes wear their own competition bibs. Team leaders will receive the bibs during the presentation.

Equipment: The organizer will provide equipment (shot, discus, javelin, hammer) for all categories of men and women. Competitors in the pole vault must have their own poles. Own equipment must be handed over to the control for approval no later than 9:30 under the main stands at the stadium. Unapproved equipment may not be used in the competition.

Attempts and measurement: in all throws, long & triple jumps, competitors have 6 attempts. Each attempt is measured.

Progression Heights in the Competition: in the High jump by 4 cm, in the Pole vault by 10 cm.

Relays: The composition of the relays will be reported by the team manager to the race office no later than 60 minutes before the start. The sum of the ages for women must be at least 180 years and for men 200 years. Each team can nominate 1 relay 4x 100 m and 1 relay 4x 400 m in the women's category and the same in the men's category.

Rules for walking:

- Footwear according to World Athletics TP 5, Athletic Shoe Regulation 2025
- Sole height - 40 mm
- Create a Penalty Zone according to TP 54.7.3., i.e. for 3000 m a penalty time of half a minute (30s) after the third red card, after the fourth the athlete is DQ.
- Link to verify permitted footwear models: certcheck.worldathletics.org

Presentation of competitors: The presentation of competitors ends 30 minutes before the start of the technical disciplines and 10 minutes before the start of the running discipline at the discipline referee, respectively starter's assistant. Competitors arrive with their start number already attached. After completing the discipline, the competitor is obliged to leave the stadium area.

Changing rooms: Will be available in the main building. The organizer is not responsible for any damage or loss.

Awards ceremony and dinner: Price **20,-€/person**. Hotel EMPIRE (www.hotelempire.sk). The team manager will register the participants of the awards ceremony and dinner in the competition registration form by selecting another discipline marked "Awards ceremony". The registration deadline is the same as for the competition registration.

Payment terms: in cash at the team manager meeting

Parking: Parking is charged around the stadium. Recommended parking is in the large parking lot near the Aquapark – AQUA WELLNESS Trnava, Rybníková 16 street, Trnava

Catering: A variety of food and drinks outlets will be available near the stadium

Medical service (First aid service): First aid services will be provided by qualified first-aid staff from Slovak Red Cross and will be available during the race in the finish area.

Protests and Appeals: Protests are governed by rule 8 of the WA Athletics Technical Rules. Protests concerning the result or conduct of an event shall be made within 30 minutes of the official announcement of the result of that event. Any protest shall be made orally to the Referee of discipline by an athlete. An appeal against the decision of the discipline referee can be filed in writing to the chief race referee within 30 minutes after the official announcement of the discipline referee's decision, together with a deposit of €10. The appeal is decided by a three-member jury.

Jury: Representative of the Organizing Committee, Technical Director, Chief referee

Statement: The organizer is not responsible for any damage or loss during the race. Competitors start at their own risk.
